MEMORIAL DAY



Originally called Decoration Day, Memorial Day was borne out of the Civil War as a way to honor and remember those that died while serving for the United States of America. It was officially proclaimed on May 5, 1868, by General John Logan, commander of the Grand Army of the Republic, that May 30th would be the designated day of recognition. The first state to officially recognize the day was New York in 1873. In 1971, the "Uniform Monday Holiday Act" changed the observation from May 30th to the last Monday in May.

TREE AND BRUSH CLEAN UP

During the month of MAY, the Town of Gilcrest will provide a drop site for trees and brush. The site is located at the **NW corner of the detention area at 11th St and Starbird Ave.** The gate will be open for your convenience on the following dates and times:

Friday May 14th: 7:30 am - 3:00pm
Saturday May 15th: 7:30am - 3:00pm

The only items allowed at the Tree/Brush drop off site are: Tree limbs, leaves, weeds, used wood (provided no other materials are attached)

WATERING RESTRICTIONS



Effective May 5, 2021 through October 15, 2021

The following restrictions shall apply to all potable water taken from the Town water system:

- Tap holders with even numbered street address may water only on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday.
- Tap holders with odd numbered street address may water only on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday.
- No Watering on Friday and no watering on any day between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM.
- Businesses and organizations who demonstrate a particular need may request an amendment to the above schedule, by permit only.
- Use of water to wash any motor vehicle allowed only with a restrictive nozzle or bucket of water.
- The filling, refilling, or adding of water to any indoor or outdoor pool is allowed during the tap holder's designated day and time as stated above.
- Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes is allowed by permit only.
- Gardens may be watered by means of hand help hose or sprinkler system any day, except between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM, and by drip irrigation system anytime.
- Additional watering for new sod or grass seed is allowed by permit only. Permits are available at the Town Hall.



KEEPING WEEDS/GRASSES CUT Gilcrest Municipal Code

Sec. 7-41 Weed, grass or brush growth unlawful when. It is unlawful for any person, corporation or association who is an owner or lessee or any agent, servant, representative or employee of such owner, lessee or occupant having control of any lot, tract or parcel of land or on or along the sidewalk, street or alley adjacent to the same between the property line and the curb or middle of they alley or for ten (10) feet outside the property line if there is no curb, to allow any growth of weeds, grass or brush to a height greater than six (6) inches or in any such manner that would constitute a fire hazard.
